You'll have access to 24-hour skilled nursing care, along with onsite occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech therapy services.

### What Is Short-Term Rehab?

At Edgerton Hospital, our Short-Term Rehab program is designed to assist you in achieving your prior level of independence so you can safely return to your home environment. We offer the following specialized services within a hospital setting:

- 24-hour registered nurses on staff
- 24-hour emergency department with physician on site
- Hospitalists on site daily
- Specialized wound care with certified wound care nurse
- IV therapy
- Respiratory therapy
- In-house pharmacy
- Registered dietitian
- Personalized activity program
- Patient and family services
- Discharge planning

This program is a Medicare-certified Swing Bed program.



### What You Need to Know About Short-Term Rehab.

- Short-Term Rehab (technically called Swing Bed) refers to the practice of moving patients from one level of care – acute care that requires hospitalization – to the next level – continued skilled nursing and rehabilitation services as you continue your recovery.
- The average length of Short-Term Rehab care varies based on need.
- Even if you have surgery or were hospitalized elsewhere, you can transfer from that facility following discharge to receive Short-Term Rehab care close to home at Edgerton Hospital.
- Short-Term Rehab generally qualifies for Medicare coverage with the following specific conditions:



Your Short-Term Rehab care must be related to an acute hospital stay.



You must need skilled nursing or skilled rehabilitative services on a daily basis. The services you need must also be complex enough that they are required to be performed by or under the supervision of professional or technical personnel.



You must have had a three-day qualifying stay in an acute care setting in the past 30 days.
