When Infusion Services are Needed, We're Here for You

Edgerton Hospital offers a comfortable environment for patients to receive outpatient, provider-ordered infusions and injections.

The friendly staff and nurses provide infusion therapy treatments to patients with a variety of conditions, including:

- Cancer
- Anemia
- Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Rheumatoid Arthritis
- Crohn's Disease
- Osteoporosis
- Infection

Specific medication infusions include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Specialty medications like Reclast, Tysabri®, Remicade® and Radicava®
- IV hydration/electrolyte replacement
- Iron therapy
- Immunoglobulin therapy (IVIG)
- Antibiotics
- Subcutaneous injections (including Prolia®, Boniva® and Fasenra®)
- Central venous access device care and maintenance
