Scheduling – If you need to have your blood drawn, you can do one of the following:

- Call the clinic at 608-868-3526 to schedule a lab draw
- Stop at the clinic on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. (bring a paper copy of your order, unless provider has submitted it)
- Stop at the Edgerton Hospital Laboratory anytime, 11101 N. Sherman Rd, Edgerton
